A Green Solution with Economic Value Suiting the Country's Development Plan

- Globally, between \$80 billion and \$120 billion worth of plastic packaging is lost to the economy every year as packaging is discarded after its first use. (NPEC, 2017)
- The Country's government aims to improve waste management by increasing trash processed from 67.5M tons by 2019 to 339.4M tons by 2024 (The Country's Building Plan 2020-2024)
- The per capita Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) generation in ASEAN is 1.14 kg/capita/day. In terms of total annual MSW generation, The Country generates the highest quantity of municipal waste with 64 million tonnes/year. (WEF, 2020)
